



Surety Bond Form

It is OUC policy that all commercial deposits, including surety bonds, are non refundable until termination of service. If you have not done so, please contact Commercial Services to determine the deposit amount needed to initiate service. The telephone number is 407.423.9018. Once in the menu, press option 3, then 4, 5.

OUC policy requires a deposit sufficient to cover two (2) times the estimated average monthly bill for services, and reserves the right to request an increase if bills exceed the amount of the bond. Please note all deposits are independent from any engineering fees you may have paid to provide service to your business.

If you are on OUC's website, www.ouc.com, simply tab through the surety bond form and type in the information requested, or if printing the form, simply tab and delete the numbers 1-16. Be sure to type the deposit amount that was quoted to you by the Commercial Service Representative. Any deviation from original deposit quote will prolong the initiation or transfer of service process.

Once the bond form has been fully executed and all parties have signed and their signatures witnessed, return to OUC with original signatures and Power of Attorney. At that time, we will be happy to process your request. Our mailing address is:

Principal is the client to be insured, or indemnitor.

Surety is the Insurance Company.

Attorney In Fact is the authorized person to sign on behalf of the Principal. They do not have to be a licensed attorney.

Florida Resident Agent is a designated person with the insurance company that receives notice on behalf of the Principal.

Obligee is Orlando Utilities Commission or OUC.

The **Attorney In Fact** and the **Florida Resident Agent** can be the same person.
