The City of St. Cloud has begun single-stream recycling curbside collection as of October 6, 2011. The following information is to help you go green with "Blue."

Collection Schedule Changes Starting In October 2011

If your garbage collection days were **Monday** and **Thursday**, beginning October 3 your new schedule will be:

- Monday — garbage collection
- Thursday — recycling collection
- No change in yard waste collection day

If your garbage collection days were **Tuesday** and **Friday**, beginning October 4 your new schedule will be:

- Tuesday — garbage collection
- Friday — recycling collection
- No change in yard waste collection day

**All recyclable items go in the blue container; separation is not required!
However, all jars, bottles and cans should be rinsed out and caps removed prior to placement.**

The Following Items *Can Be Recycled*

- ✓ Glass jars & bottles
- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Tin, steel or aerosol cans
- ✓ Plastic bottles
- ✓ Food boxes
- ✓ Paperback & phone books
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Cardboard (flatten all boxes)
- ✓ Magazines & catalogs
- ✓ Newspapers & inserts
- ✓ Office paper & file folders
(without wax liners)
- ✓ Paper bags

The Following Items *Cannot Be Recycled*

- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Electronics
- ✗ Hardback books
- ✗ Ceramics or dishes
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Plastic tubs, jars & trays
- ✗ Plastic grocery bags
- ✗ Motor oil containers
- ✗ Household hazardous waste
- ✗ Light bulbs, window glass or mirrors
- ✗ Yard waste or trash
