Depending upon the type, age and condition of the equipment in your house, duct repair can be as simple as doing it yourself with a few wraps of tape or it can require more extensive work. To qualify for this residential rebate, your home must have a central air conditioning system of 5.5 tons or less, your ducts must be fixed with mastic and Underwriters Laboratory (UL) approved duct tape, and you must show your receipts.
