To qualify for this program, your total annual family income must be \$40,000 or less. In addition, your home must be equipped with all-electric household appliances. Renters can also qualify by having their landlord sign an authorization form for the work to be performed.

STEP 1

Call **407.423.9018** in Orlando or **407.957.7373** in St. Cloud and speak to a customer service representative to sign up for a free home energy survey.

STEP 2

Following your free home energy survey, the auditor will determine if you qualify for the Home Energy Fix-Up Program.

STEP 3

If you qualify, an OUC representative will provide the necessary guidance to help you upgrade your home.
