PRESERVING HABITATS FOR ENDANGERED SPECIES

At OUC, we proudly serve a diverse ecological region in Central Florida, striving to protect and enhance the environment.

Our environmental team recently initiated prescribed burns covering 1,200 acres

at Stanton Energy Center in east
Orange County. Burns started
in January and will end in June

2024. They mitigate wildfire risk and safeguard habitats for over 40 species, including the endangered Red-cockaded Woodpecker. Committed to wildlife protection, we collect data contributing to Florida's natural heritage knowledge.

SAFETY TIPS FOR WORKING OUTSIDE

It's a great time of year to enjoy our beautiful weather by cleaning up the outside of your home. However, electricity can transfer to equipment that's too close to a power line, even if it's not touching.



LOOK ABOVE – Make sure the area above is clear of power lines, and keep cranes, ladders, pruners and other equipment at least 10 feet away. If you think power lines may interfere with your project, call OUC at 407-423-9018 well in advance before starting your project. We can help determine the safest way to complete your project.

CALL BEFORE YOU DIG

 Before digging on your property, Florida law requires you to contact Sunshine State One-Call at 800-432-4770 or 8-1-1



to find out where underground pipes and electric lines are located. Please call at least two business days before starting, whether it involves heavy equipment or even simple landscaping.
