



## SEWER RATE ADJUSTMENT

Effective October 1, 2020

The capital and operating costs of collecting, transmitting, and treating wastewater, and the cost of the distribution of reclaimed water, have been steadily increasing.

The City is, therefore, proposing a 5% increase in your wastewater rates for 2020-2021. The new rates, if approved, will be as shown below.

### RESIDENTIAL RATES:

### COMMERCIAL RATES:

(Includes Commercial, Industrial, and Master Metered multiple family living units).

#### Inside City Limits:

Water usage is divided by 7000 gallons (result rounded to nearest .10) times \$21.06 is the capacity charge, plus \$5.09 times each thousand gallons of water usage on current bill. Minimum \$21.06 capacity charge.

#### Outside City Limits:

Water usage is divided by 7000 gallons (result rounded to nearest .10) times \$26.33 is the capacity charge, plus \$6.34 times each thousand gallons of water usage on current bill. Minimum \$26.33 capacity charge.
