



## Safe Drinking Water Act

### ***Unregulated Contaminant Monitoring***

The 1996 Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA) amendments require that once every five years the EPA issues a new list of no more than 30 unregulated contaminants to be monitored for a 12-month period by Public Water Systems (PWS).

This monitoring provides a basis for future regulatory actions to protect public health. At present, no health standards have been established for unregulated contaminants.
