USE FERTILIZERS, HERBICIDES, AND PESTICIDES SPARINGLY AND FOLLOW LABEL INSTRUCTIONS.

LABEL IS LAW!

Keep fertilizer off streets and sidewalks, and away from lakes and stormwater drains. Avoid applying within 10 feet of paved areas, storm drains, or water bodies. Broadcast spreaders must have a deflector shield to keep granular fertilizer off paved surfaces and out of storm drains and waterways.

- Only apply during dry weather.
- Use **ZERO** phosphorous lawn fertilizers.

If any dry chemicals or fertilizer should fall onto paved areas, immediately sweep or blow back onto lawn or properly contain for reuse.
