THERMOSTAT MANAGEMENT


- Set your thermostat at 78 degrees or higher when cooling and 68 degrees or lower when heating your home.

- Plant trees or move container plants in front of windows to aid with shading.

Replace old, inefficient incandescent lights with energy-efficient LED bulbs.
