Manage Your Account with myOUC

With myOUC, you can easily manage your OUC account online or on the go . . . from any device. Just go to www.ouc.com and click Register to set up your profile, if you haven't already. You will need your OUC account number and PIN located at the top left of your OUC bill. Once you've created your username, password and set up your security questions, you'll have full access to all of our online features, including making a payment, paperless billing, enrolling in Autopay and more.

When you sign up for myOUC, you will be enrolled in paperless billing and each month you will receive an email letting you know your statement is ready to view. If you prefer to continue receiving paper statements, simply change your preference when logged into your myOUC account.



More than 81,000 OUC customers

have signed up for a myOUC online account to pay their OUC bills, go paperless, track their energy and water usage, report a problem and more.

Utility Scam Alert



OUC wants to make you aware of a nationwide utility scam targeting small commercial businesses and attempting to collect payments. We've had recent reports in the Orlando area. In several cases, customers lost money to criminals claiming to be from OUC. If you receive a call threatening disconnection if a payment is not made immediately using a GreenDot Money Pak pre-paid card, please hang up and contact local law enforcement and then alert OUC.

OUC does not require customers to use pre-paid cards. We provide advance notification via post card regarding past due bills and potential service interruptions. If we do call, it is a week in advance and we do not request personal information, such as social security or credit card numbers.
