DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME Checklist

As clocks “spring forward” **March 10**, be sure to follow this twice-a-year household safety checklist:

- ✓ Check/replace batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
- ✓ Check/replace expired items in your first aid kit.
- ✓ Check/replace items in your hurricane/emergency kit.
- ✓ Check fire extinguisher pressure and expiration date.
- ✓ Check/replace burned out or dimming exterior light bulbs.
- ✓ Change flashlight and weather alert radio batteries.



ADJUST IRRIGATION SETTINGS

When the clock changes, so do the St. Johns River Water Management District’s irrigation rules. Here are the days you’re allowed to water your yard beginning DST:

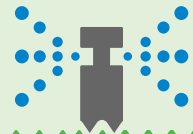
Saturday & Wednesday: Homes with odd-numbered or no addresses.

Thursday & Sunday: Homes with even-numbered addresses.

Tuesday & Friday: Non-residential (commercial, public, industrial) properties.

Remember to water only when necessary for **no more than one hour per zone and never between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.**
