## PRESERVING HABITATS FOR ENDANGERED SPECIES



At OUC, we take great pride in serving one of the most ecologically diverse areas in the nation. That's why we work hard each and every day to protect and enhance Central Florida's environment. In January, our environmental team began conducting prescribed burns of 1,200 acres of vegetation at the Stanton Energy Center (SEC) in east Orange County.

These burns help reduce the danger of wildfires and preserve the habitats of the more than

40 species that call the area home, including the endangered Red-cockaded Woodpecker (pictured right). We're committed to protecting wildlife and their habitats around our infrastructure and collecting relevant data that contributes to scientific knowledge of Florida's natural heritage.

## SAFETY TIPS FOR WORKING OUTDOORS

**LOOK ABOVE YOU** - Make sure the area above you is clear of power lines, and keep cranes, ladders, pruners and other equipment at least 10 feet away. If you think lines may interfere with your project, call OUC at **407-423-9018** at least two business days prior to starting your project. We can help determine the safest way to complete your project.



### **CALL BEFORE YOU DIG** -

Before digging on your property, Florida law requires you to contact **Sunshine State One-Call** at **800-432-4770** or **8-1-1** to find where underground pipes and electric lines are located. ## DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME BEGINS MARCH 13... SPRING AHEAD!

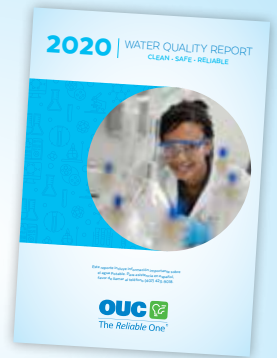
The twice-a-year time changes are perfect opportunities to review your household safety checklist:

- Check/replace batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide detectors
- Check/replace items in your hurricane/emergency kit
- Check/replace burned out or dimmed exterior light bulbs
- Check fire extinguisher pressure/expiration date
- Change flashlight/weather alert radio batteries
