April Is Water Conservation Month

Did you know that the average household uses nearly 300 gallons of water each day? As we observe Water Conservation Month, let's see if we can reduce our water consumption by at least five gallons a day. Protecting the environment while reducing your water bill sounds like a no-brainer, doesn't it? Here are a few water-saving tips:

-  Repair faucet leaks inside and outside your home.
-  Wash only full loads in your dishwasher and clothes washer.
-  Install water saving showerheads, toilets, faucet aerators and appliances.
-  Shorten your shower time by just one minute.
-  Turn the water off while brushing your teeth or shaving.
-  Check your irrigation system for leaks, broken sprinkler heads and incorrect timer settings. And be sure to water in accordance with water management restrictions.



A Naturally Clean Water Source

OUC's water comes from the Lower Floridan Aquifer, an underground reservoir that in many places is a quarter of a mile below the earth's surface. The aquifer is fed by rainwater that is filtered through hundreds of feet of rock, undergoing a natural cleansing process. After pumping water from the aquifer to our water plants, OUC carefully treats it with ozone, the strongest disinfectant available, to ensure its safety and enhance its quality all the way to your faucet. OUC even has its own Water Quality Lab that conducts

nearly 20,000 tests each year to ensure quality and safety. To prove that H₂OUC is exceptional, we compared our test results with those of four popular bottled brands. As we expected, OUC's water met or surpassed the bottled brands in virtually every aspect.
