- 2 Register for Outage Text Alerts Report an outage and get updates via text, voice or email. Alerts are available in English and Spanish! Text REG to 69682 to register or visit OUC.com/alerts.
- 3 View OUC's Interactive Outage Map –
  Get real-time outage information, including locations and estimated restoration times.

- 4 Request Tree Trimming Let us know if tree limbs appear to interfere with power lines.
- **5 Download OUC's Tropical Weather Guide** Find important phone numbers, preparation tips, safety information and more.
- 6 View Safety/Informational Videos Learn how to stay safe around power lines, how we restore power, and more.

### MAY IS NATIONAL ELECTRICAL SAFETY MONTH

While OUC commits to be safe always, we encourage you to take safety precautions inside and outside your own home as well.

#### **INDOOR SAFETY TIPS**

- Install light bulbs that are the correct wattage for the size of fixtures.
- Regularly inspect electrical cords and extension cords for damage.
- Repair or replace an appliance that repeatedly blows a fuse or trips a circuit, or if it has caused an electric shock.
- Protect children and pets by covering unused wall outlets with plastic safety caps.
- Never remove the third prong of a threepronged plug. The third prong is designed to safely ground electricity.
- Test smoke alarms monthly, change batteries yearly, and replace units every 10 years.

#### **OUTDOOR SAFETY TIPS**

- Call 8-1-1 before you dig.
   Many utility lines are underground.
- Keep children and pets a safe distance away when you operate a mower, chain saw or other power equipment.
- Don't use electrical tools or appliances in the rain, on wet surfaces, or while standing in water.
- Use only weather-resistant heavy gauge extension cords marked "For Outdoor Use."
- Always keep tools, object and yourself at least 10 feet away from overhead power lines.
- Don't overload outdoor electrical and/or extension cords or allow them to run through water on the ground.
