OUC PARTNERS WITH AIRPORT ON SUSTAINABLE ENERGY SOLUTIONS



OUC will help raise the visibility of Orlando International Airport's (MCO) sustainability efforts with installations of a floating solar array and 67 electric vehicle (EV) charging stations – part of a 20-year agreement that entrusts OUC to deliver and manage a unique portfolio of energy and water services at Orlando International's new South Terminal Complex.

The airport's floating solar array will be shaped as a giant "O" and situated in a pond between the main and South terminals, making it highly visible to visitors arriving to Orlando. Meanwhile, the 67 EV charging stations will be positioned so they're readily accessible to EV drivers and visible to travelers passing through MCO. Under terms of the agreement with the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA), OUC will also provide chilled

water services, emergency distribution power and back-up generation, as well as on-site staffing for airport facilities.

"We're honored that GOAA is relying on us to provide such a diverse range of services," said **Clint Bullock**, OUC General Manager & CEO. "These additions display our commitment to being one of the greenest cities in the nation. Our great 96-year reputation is opening doors to new opportunities and partnerships with customers who need innovative and customized services."

FEDERAL GRANT TO HELP OUC, LYNX ELECTRIFY MASS TRANSIT


A recent \$1.9 million Low or No Emission grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) will help OUC and LYNX, Central Florida's mass transit provider, purchase or lease zero-emission and low-emission busses to operate on the LYMMO Grapefruit, Lime and North Quarter lines. LYNX will benefit from real-world operating experiences and OUC from important battery performance data.
