10 EASY WAYS TO SAVE ENERGY & MONEY

- 1 **Adjust Your Thermostat** – Keep it at 78°F or higher in summer and 68°F or lower in winter to save up to 8% on energy costs. However, if higher temperatures pose a health risk, adjust accordingly for your safety.
- 2 **Maintain Your HVAC Unit** – Clear the area around it to improve efficiency by up to 15%.
- 3 **Use Ceiling Fans Wisely** – Rotate counterclockwise in summer, clockwise in winter, and turn off when leaving the room.
- 4 **Control Sunlight Exposure** – Block heat in summer and let warmth in during winter with blinds or drapes.
- 5 **Change Air Filters** – A clean filter keeps your system running efficiently.
- 6 **Seal Air Leaks** – Use weather stripping and caulking to reduce energy waste.
- 7 **Use Appliances Efficiently** – Wash full loads and use cold water when possible.
- 8 **Clear Dryer Vents** – Improves efficiency and prevents fire hazards.
- 9 **Unplug Devices** – Many electronics drain power even when turned off.
- 10 **Adjust Water Heater Temperature** – Set it to 120°F to prevent energy waste.

7 Simple Ways to Save Water on Your Lawn

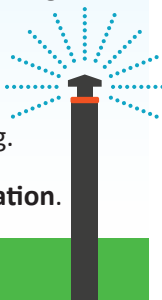


Maintaining a healthy lawn while conserving water is easy with these seven tips.

1. Use a rain shut-off device to prevent irrigation during rainfall.
2. Install a smart irrigation controller to optimize watering schedules.
3. Mow at the right height (3–4 inches) to reduce evaporation.
4. Leave grass clippings on the lawn to retain moisture and add nutrients.
5. Plant Florida-friendly landscaping to reduce water needs and qualify for rebates.
6. Check for leaks and schedule a water audit to detect inefficiencies.
7. Use a cistern for water reuse by collecting rainwater for landscaping reduces irrigation needs.
